**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 005.15**

**TO: ALL WATER DISTRICTS / RWSAS**

**SUBJECT: LISTAHANG TUBIG PROJECT REMINDER**

This is a reiteration of LWUA Memorandum Circular No. 008-14 signed Oct 29, 2014 enjoining all water districts and rural water supply and sanitation associations (RWSAs) to participate in the "Listahang Tubig" national survey. As of April 24, 2015 there were only 173 water districts out of the 514 water districts that have encoded in the Listahang Tubig website. The water districts should have entered their data by April 30, 2015 so that at the end of May 2015 the Listahang Tubig data can be processed for publication. Those water districts who have not yet complied please enter now your data in the Listahang Tubig website (<http://listahangtubig.cloudapp.net>) by downloading and filling out the survey forms and encoding them in the Listahang Tubig website. If you encounter problems in entering data please document your problems or if you have reasons for not being able to comply please email them at [lwua\\_research@yahoo.com](mailto:lwua_research@yahoo.com).

A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between The National Water Resources Board (NWRB), Local Water Utilities Administration (LWUA) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) was signed to implement a national survey to identify and develop a database for all water utilities in the country. The initiative, called "Listahang Tubig", is a project of the NWRB with the support of The World Bank Water and Sanitation Program (WB-WSP) and the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID)'s Water for Resilient Economic Growth and Stability (Be Secure) Project.

The national survey is being conducted in order to improve the management of all water resources in the country and enhance regulation of water users. Your full cooperation is hereby enjoined.
