## MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

No. 008.15

TO : ALL CONCERNED WATER DISTRICTS

SUBJECT : COMPLIANCE WITH THE SUPREME COURT MANDAMUS

Pursuant to RA 9275 and Supreme Court Mandamus of 2008, the Local Water Utilities Administration (LWUA), through the local water districts in coordination with the DENR, is ordered to provide, install, and maintain sewerage and sanitation facilities and the efficient and safe collection, treatment and disposal of sewerage in the province of Laguna, Cavite, Bulacan, Pampanga, and Bataan at the earliest possible time.

In view of the above, pursuant to LWUA Board Resolution No. 36 series 2015, the following water districts (WD) are required to submit Board Resolution committing to implement a sanitation program in compliance with the said Supreme Court Mandamus:

The above WDs shall submit to LWUA, its plan to provide, install, operate and maintain sewerage and sanitation facilities within its area of operations within six (6) months from the adoption of the WD Resolution. LWUA shall in turn, evaluate and consolidate the plan, together with those submitted by other concerned water districts covered by the continuing mandamus and submit the same to the Manila Bay Advisory Committee (MBAC) for its approval within one (1) month from the time all concerned WDs have submitted their respective plan.

Upon receipt of the MBAC's approval of the plan, the concerned WDs shall submit to LWUA a quarterly progressive report on the implementation of the plan, which shall be due on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month following each quarter. LWUA shall submit the concerned WD's quarterly progressive report to the MBAC for monitoring purposes, and to ensure substantial compliance to the plan until the completion thereof on December 31, 2020.

LWUA, shall likewise monitor and evaluate the concerned WD's implementation of the project. For this purpose, the concerned WD shall provide LWUA personnel, access to the pertinent data and information concerning the implementation of the project.
